

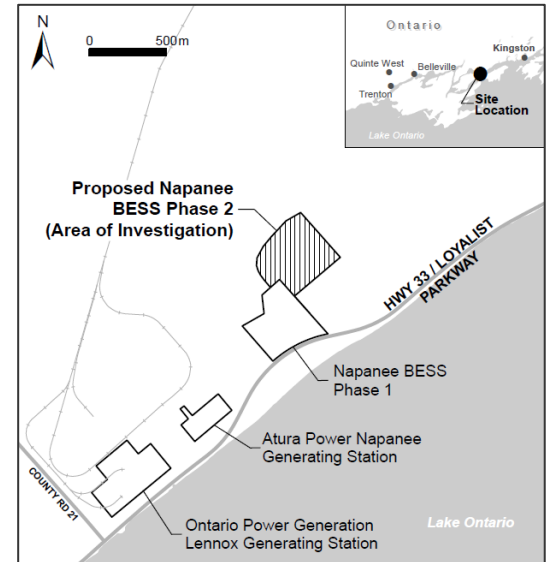
Invitation to a Public Meeting

Napanee Battery Energy Storage System Phase 2

To prepare for future electricity demand and support a reliable grid for Ontarians, the Independent Electricity System Operator initiated a Long-Term 2 Request for Proposals to secure new electricity resources that could be in service into the 2030s and beyond.

Atura Power, a subsidiary of Ontario Power Generation, is proposing to construct the Napanee Battery Energy Storage System Phase 2 in the Town of Greater Napanee. The proposed project is located north of Lake Ontario and next to the Napanee Battery Energy Storage System Phase 1 project under construction.

Project Description

The proposed project will provide up to 300 megawatts of electricity storage and output for up to eight hours into the system when electricity demand is high. The project will include battery units and a system that will convert electrical alternating current to direct current for battery storage, as well as other components such as transformers, emergency power, support buildings, and transmission connection facilities.
